



# 21) WATCH CAP RIBBED KNIT  
w/DP NEEDLES from WW II web site

Materials: 1 skein acrylic worsted:

Yarn colors: please consult the color chart.

2 Pairs (4) of #4 10" long **double pointed** needles,  
tapestry needle

Note: no cuff for the land forces

**Work body 2 ½” longer if knitting for the Navy, only in black.** Note: can be worked in your choice: in K1, P 1 or K 2, P 2 . **Be aware** end of row may have a st or 2 extra, just K it to compensate.

Note: row 1 is considered the right side.

Cast on 96sts, 32 on each of 3 needles.

Join and work in ribbing of K 2, P 2 for 6" (8 - 8 ½” longer in black)

K 1 round plain.

Decrease 1 st at both ends of each needle, as follows:

\* K1, slip 1, K 1, pass the slipped st over the knitted, (slip-K-pass),

K to within 3 sts of end of needle, K2tog, K the last st; repeat from \* until 4 sts remain on each needle.

Break off yarn, thread end into a darning needle, draw through all sts, twice, tighten and darn in end.

Before you attach the logo tag PLEASE write a short note to the service person, with your name & address on back. Using tapestry needle, **secure the card INSIDE up in the crown to insure it's not torn off.**
