



23) WRISTLET CROCHETED

Adapted "KNIT FOR VICTORY" book

Yarn: 3 oz. acrylic worsted,
please consult the color chart for colors.

K hook and tapestry needle

Mitt should fit snug, but not binding. Try it on a man.

Pattern is worked in Back Loops Only (BLO)

Gauge: 3 st/in., 12 st/4 in.; 4 rows/in., 16 rows/4in.

Ch 34, with a tail about 28 inches.

Row 1: Working in 2nd ch from hook, work 1 sc in each ch, ch 1, turn. (34 sc)

Row 2: Work 1 sc in BLO in each st, ch 1, turn. (34 sc)

Rows 3-26: Repeat row 2.

Fasten off and weave in ends. Rectangle should be 11" long x 7" wide.

Finishing:

Using safety pins, match the stitches together along long edge, approx. 11 inches. Whipstitch 20 stitches up, about 6 ½ ". Thread yarn through one side for 5 stitches, about 1 ½" (thumb opening). Whipstitch remaining 9 stitches. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Thumb (worked in the round, do not turn)

Join yarn anywhere in thumb opening.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, add 13 more sc evenly around opening, join with a sl st to the first st. (14 sc)

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc around, join with a sl st to the first st. (14 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in next 10 sc, sc dec two times, join with a sl st to the first st. (12 sc)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Repeat for second mitt.

Before you attach the logo PLEASE write a short note to the service person, with your name & address on back. Using tapestry needle, **secure between the two mitts 2" from an edge to insure it is not torn off.**
