

6) KNIT HEADBAND IN RIBBING

Acrylic worsted weight yarn: black, DARK brown, DARK camouflage, DARK olive green and DARK tan.

GREAT FOR USING SMALL AMOUNTS OF YARN, the color chart shown below is just a sample.

Note: because this is ribbing, the cast on edge would be tighter than the bind off edge needles size: 9 & 7 or 8 & 6

Complementary colors in worsted weight yarn, in 2, 3 to 5 color combinations, be creative. The bands can be done in 17 or 19 rows.

Cast on with the color you have the most of in multiples of 5: 95 or 100 colors and ribbing for 17 rows:

brown color A
tan color B
olive green color C
black color D

5 colors and ribbing for 19 rows:

brown color A
tan color B
olive green color C
black color D
camouflage color E

Cast on w/A

Row 1: k 3, p2 across A
Row 2: p 3, k 2 across A
Row 3: repeat row 1 A
Row 4: repeat row 2 A
Row 5: k 3, p2 B
Row 6: p 3, k 2 B
Row 7: k 3, p 2 C
Row 8: p 3, k 2, C
Row 9: k 3, p 2, C
Row 10: p 3, k 2 C
Row 11: k 3, p2 C
Row 12: p 3, k 2 B
Row 13: k 3, p 2 B
Row 14: p 3, k 2 A
Row 15: k 3, p 2 A
Row 16: p 3, k2 A
Row 17: k 3, p 2 A
Bind off, sew ends

Cast on with brown

Row 1: k 3, p2 across brown
Row 2: p 3, k 2 across brown
Row 3: repeat row 1 brown
Row 4: repeat row 2 tan
Row 5: k 3, p 2 tan
Row 6: p 3, k 2 olive green
Row 7: k 3, p 2 olive green
Row 8: p 3, k 2, gold
Row 9: k 3, p 2, multi
Row 10: p 3, k 2 multi
Row 11: k 3, p 2 multi
Row 12: p 2, k 2 gold
Row 13: k 3, p 2 olive green
Row 14: p 3, k 2 olive green
Row 15: k 3, p 2 tan
Row 16: p 3, k 2 tan
Row 17: k 3, p 2 brown
Row 18: p 3, k 2 brown
Row 19: k 3, p2 brown
Bind off, sew ends.
