



#10) HELMET KNIT RIBBED w/OPEN FACE
1 skein acrylic worsted weight yarn.

Colors: please consult the color page chart.
#8 or 9 straight or circular needle, not joined,
seam requires closing. tapestry needle

Gauge: 6 sts =1" unstretched rib pattern

Note: can be worked up in K1, P1, K2, P2 or K3, P2 sequence*. **Be aware** end of row may have a st or 2 extra, just K it to compensate.

Note: row 1 is considered the right side.

Cast on 95 Work even using K1, P1 sequence* for 44 rows , approximately 8"

Row 30: work 36sts in rib pattern, bind off 23sts, join new ball of yarn, continue in ribbing pattern for remaining 36sts.

Rows 31 to 50: work even as stated in row 30, 36sts on each side

Row 51: work 36sts in rib pattern, cast on 23sts, continue with this same ball for the remaining 36sts

Rows: 52 to 74 work even.

Shape crown section: Change to stockinette stitch

Rows:

75 *K2tog, K 4, repeat from * across, ending with K2tog, K 2.

76 P across

77 *K 2, K2tog, repeat from *, ending with K 2, K3 tog.

78 P across

79 K2tog across.

Cut yarn leaving enough to weave the back seam. Thread tapestry needle and pass through last 6 sts 2 times and pull tight. Before you attach the logo tag **PLEASE** write a short note to the service person, with your name & address on back. Using tapestry needle, **secure the card INSIDE up in the crown to insure it's not torn off.**
